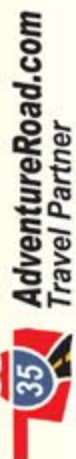

The spirit that turned cowboys into legends, cattlemen into men of fortune, and oilmen into giants, lives on in Duncan, Oklahoma!

Originally a small trading post at the intersection of the Chisholm Trail and the military passage between Ft. Arbuckle and Ft. Sill, Duncan has played many a part in Oklahoma's exciting history.

When William Duncan brought his family to the area, the Rock Island Railroad had just extended its lines from Kansas to Texas. Cowboy camps were plentiful, so, he built a trading post on the Chisholm Trail to serve train passengers, cowboys and new settlers. By 1892 Duncan had become an exciting frontier town.

The oil industry brought even greater prosperity when area oil discoveries soon became Oklahoma's highest producing fields. One particular oilman, Erle P. Halliburton, left his legacy in Duncan by perfecting a way of making oil production easier. Established in 1919, Halliburton Energy Services, Inc. today, has 201 offices in 22 states and 20 foreign countries.

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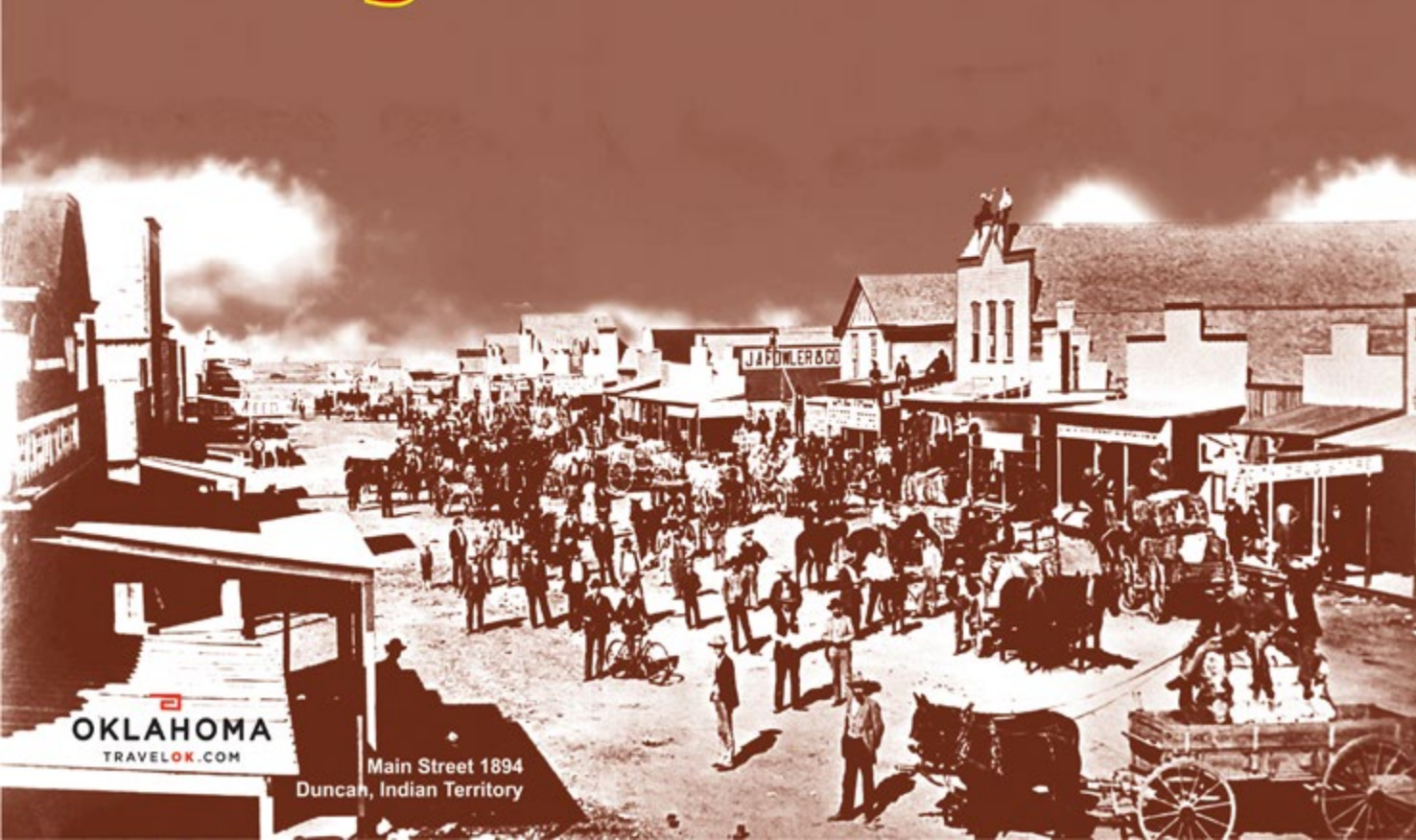

In its time, the Chisholm Trail was considered one of the wonders of the western world. Herds with as many as ten thousand cattle were driven from Texas over the trail to Kansas. From 1867 to 1889, the Chisholm Trail was the major north and south road in the plains. Over the course of twenty years, the trail saw millions of heads of cattle driven with rich stories told and retold of life on the trail.

There are ruts located in and near Duncan. Much of the original trail is paved or is on private property.

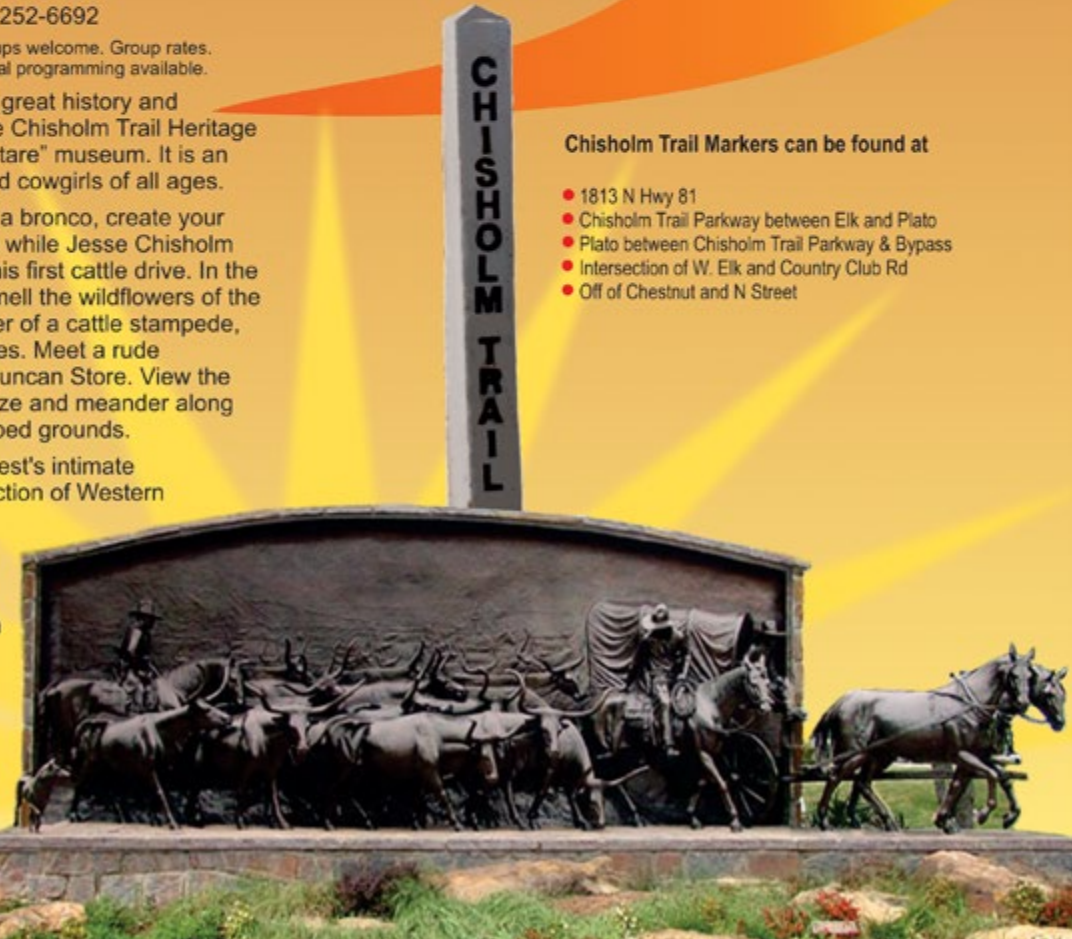

Commemorating and celebrating the great history and heritage of the old Chisholm Trail, the Chisholm Trail Heritage Center is not your typical "stop-and-stare" museum. It is an interactive adventure for cowboys and cowgirls of all ages.

Toss a rope around a Longhorn; ride a bronco, create your own brand or sit a spell at a campfire while Jesse Chisholm offers advice to a young cowboy on his first cattle drive. In the multi-sensory Experience Theater, smell the wildflowers of the Oklahoma prairie, listen to the thunder of a cattle stampede, feel the wind and rain as a storm rages. Meet a rude chuckwagon cook then relax in the Duncan Store. View the life size "On the Chisholm Trail" Bronze and meander along the trail diorama, located on landscaped grounds.

The Garis Gallery of the American West's intimate setting opens to an exceptional collection of Western paintings and sculptures. Works by Frederick Remington, George Catlin, Charles Russell, Alan Houser along with regional and local artists of note are on display in the nearly \$2 million permanent collection. Learn more about the art and the artists through a self-guided audio tour. Temporary exhibits, ranging from loans from the Smithsonian to local favorites, change about every eight weeks.

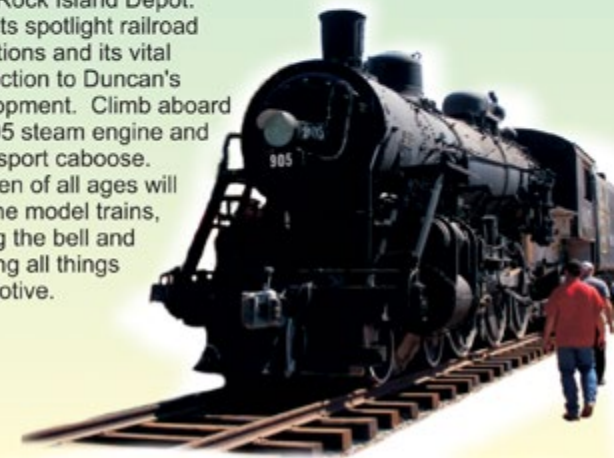

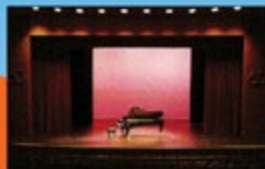

Duncan's tribute to Oklahoma's rich musical heritage. Hoyt Axton was born on March 25, 1938 in Duncan, to John Axton and Mae Boren Axton. If the name Mae Axton doesn't ring a bell, perhaps her songs will. She wrote more than 200 songs including Elvis Presley's hit "Heartbreak Hotel." Known as the "Queen Mother of Nashville," Oklahoma-raised Mae helped many singers and songwriters break into the business, such as Willie Nelson, Dolly Parton and Oklahoma's own Blake Shelton. Hoyt made his own mark as a songwriter before becoming a successful folk, country and pop singer in his own right. Any tour exploring the history of the Chisholm Trail, cowboys and cattedrives, or the culture of the untamed West would not be complete without a visit to Duncan, OK. Incredible museums, historical sites, and traditions await you; let us assist you to make the most of your group's visit.

## Chisholm Trail Tour

The trail ran from Fort Worth, TX to Abilene, KS and right through Duncan. You'll feel like you're on the trail when you visit the Chisholm Trail Heritage Center. Featuring the southwest's largest western-themed bronze statue, meet Jesse and Tex, whose life-like figures talk to you about life on the trail, use all your senses to experience the Old Trail in the multi-sensory theatre, and view additional dioramas, displays, and an art gallery. Then travel with your guide to the Trail Ruts at Monument Hill where visible remains of the Trail, etched by the millions of cattle, can still be seen. Tour options include a chuck wagon meal.

## Shopping Historical Main St.

A guide in period attire, typical of what would have been worn on Duncan's streets in the late 1800s, gives you the historical perspective of Downtown Main Street and what makes the area still unique today. Visit specialty shops and view the trivia sidewalks.



## Historic Duncan Tour

See what made Duncan what it is today; from the Chisholm Trail to Halliburton. Visit the Chisholm Trail Heritage Center, the Stephens County Historical Museum, and more!

## Historic Homes Tour

A guide will lead you through historic homes and churches in Duncan, including the Prairie House. Designed in the style that made Frank Lloyd Wright famous, it was built for one of Duncan's first citizens. An extensive renovation has returned it to its original condition. See various styles of architecture and be intrigued by the events that occurred at each. Many of the buildings are on the Historical Registry.

Recognized as the Crapemyrtle Capital of Oklahoma, Duncan's **Crapemyrtle Trail** will showcase many varieties of crape myrtles, as well as give visitors the opportunity to experience what makes Duncan a place to discover!
